INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

Members and non-members of Fungimap are welcome to publish in the *Fungimap Newsletter*.

All articles for publication in the newsletter should be submitted as an electronic copy.

Images should preferably be jpg, resolution at least 300dpi and submitted in at least the size that they are to be published. Avoid images larger than 1Mb (preferably copied to CD-ROM and posted). Images, tables and graphs should not be embedded in text and should be supplied as separate files. They may be included in text to indicate where they should be located but the editors cannot guarantee their placement.

General news items, obituaries, book reviews, reports of interesting sightings and the like can be up to one page of the *Fungimap Newsletter*, which is approximately 800 words, or 600 words with two images.

A comprehensive article about a particular genus or group of fungi may be up to two pages long, with up to four images, which is approximately 1,200 words.

Authors may be asked to edit their contributions for succinctness or to fit within page constraints.

Articles submitted for publication in the *Fungimap Newsletter* should not be submitted to any other journal or newsletter awaiting publication or have been previously published in another Newsletter or journal.

Authors submitting manuscripts are responsible for obtaining the copyright holder's permission to reproduce any material for which the author does not hold copyright.

The editors may suggest to authors that their papers be refereed where valuable external feedback may be available, especially for comprehensive treatments or new records. There will be one or two referees who would be anonymous.
