School Arrival and Departure Notice



In line with the Royal Botanic Gardens Victoria CovidSafe Plan (January 2021), school drop-off, pick-up and meeting points have changed at Cranbourne Gardens.

Schools will be entering via the Ian Potter Lakeside Precinct not the Visitor Centre.

Please read through the following information carefully and contact us if you have any questions.

Drop-off

From Term 1, 2021

- School buses are requested to pull into the Event Drop-off Point outside the Ian Potter Lakeside Precinct
- Students/teachers should then gather on the lawns of the Ian Potter Lakeside Precinct in preparation for their program.
- Buses may then park in the bays available in the main carpark.

Program Meeting Point

At the time of your program an RBGV Learning Facilitator will meet you and your student on the lawns of the Ian Potter Lakeside Precinct.

Toilets

The nearest toilets to the Ian Potter Lakeside Precinct are located at the kiosk, a short walk away.

Water

The nearest drinking water is available near the kiosk, a short walk away.

Pick-up

From Term 1, 2021:




- Please arrange for your bus driver to meet you at the school drop-off point outside the Ian Potter Lakeside Precinct at the time you will be leaving the gardens.
- The bus driver may need to exit the gardens to turn around and enter the school drop-off point to collect students – please allow 10 minutes.
